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1. PRODUCT CONFORMITY ASSESSMENT	
PROGRAM NAME	Certificate of Conformity for Shipments: Food and Beverages
PROGRAM MANDATED BY	Ministry of Public Health
IMPLEMENTATION DATE	25.01.2024
PROGRAM OBJECTIVES	Assess and verify compliance of food and beverages for export to the State of Qatar, in accordance with the regulations, rules, specifications and conditions approved by MOPH
VERIFICATION PROCESS	 Based on the documents, SGS will: Verify the conformity of the goods to the updated QATAR/GSO standards/technical regulations and requirements. Perform a physical inspection on products. Collect a sample from each consignment alongside the physical inspection. The sampling process will follow specific product QATAR/GSO standard requirements, and each sample will be marked with the SGS reference/sample sticker (the sticker serial number will be considered as the 'reference number') to enable traceability. Sampling for testing will be conducted based on the risk of the product category (details can be shared based on product details) Cartons containing samples for removal will be sealed using SGS tape. Copy of the sampling receipt will be attached to the inspection report for traceability. Samples suil be handed over to the client for the testing laboratory. Samples will be handed over to the client for testing. Testing is to be conducted at an ISO/IEC 17025-accredited laboratory



	 Once it is confirmed the sample has passed relevant tests, the Certificate of Conformity (CoC) is issued. CoC shall include: Full reference and traceability to samples drawn (sample reference number) for testing. Seal numbers (as applicable) If the product fails testing, a Non-Negotiable Report (NNR) is issued. MOPH provided with quarterly report
ROUTES	Route A : Non-registered products – involves pre-shipment inspection and pre-shipment testing of products. Physical inspection conducted to verify the labelling/marking, storage and other visual verification.
APPROVED LABORATORY	As per GSO requirements, testing must be conducted in an approved ISO/IEC 17025 accredited laboratory.
DOCUMENTATION	 Exporter submits to SGS the following documents: Request for certification and declaration of conformity. Commercial invoice Documents: Ingredient list with concentrations, Certificate of Analysis {batch-wise}, product labels/artworks and hygiene certificate MOPH registration number for product (QFR Number) Test reports from approved ISO/IEC 17025 accredited laboratory. Company's quality management system documents (ISO 9001, ISO 22000, GMP, HACCP, any FSMS certification or similar) Halal certificate from approved bodies (as applicable) Slaughter certificate from approved bodies (as applicable) Certificate of origin (as applicable) Establishment registration (as applicable)
CERTIFICATE	A Certificate of Conformity (CoC) is issued to evidence the compliance of the shipment.
